ORDER FOR RECOUNT OF JUNE 1, 2010

REPUBLICAN PARTY PRIMARY ELECTION FOR GOVERNOR

The Shelby County Republican Party and Tim James, candidate for Governor in the June 1, 2010 Republican Party Primary Election, having petitioned for a recount of the primary election results in the June 1, 2010 Republican Party Primary Election for the office of Governor and sufficient security for the cost of said recount having been given, it is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

1. There shall be a recount of the June 1, 2010 Republican Party Primary Election results for the office of Governor on Wednesday, June 16, 2010 commencing at 1:30 p.m. at the Shelby County Sheriff's Training Center, 543 McDow Road, Columbiana, Alabama. Further, the electronic voting machines will be tested at the same location on Wednesday, June 16, 2010 commencing at 1:00 p.m. The recount shall be conducted under the supervision of a trained and certified precinct election official.
2. The Sheriff of Shelby County shall deliver the unopened containers holding the ballots to the recount inspector in sufficient time for said recount to take place.
3. The Sheriff of Shelby County or his representative shall be present during the recount.
4. When the recount is completed, the ballots shall be returned to their container along with a printout of the recount results. The ballot container shall be sealed and signed by the recount inspector and the Sheriff or Sheriff's representative and returned to the custody of the Sheriff of Shelby County.
